CHURCH BENCHES - WORK COMPLETE

Some may have noticed the colour differences between benches/bench ends: this is due to the fact that a variety of woods were used including oak, soft & hard woods. It is highly likely that benches may have come from 2/3 different sources. The roundel marks on the aisle side of some benches were left by a base which held a cross.
