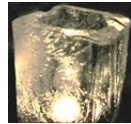

SEVENTY FIVE YEARS AGO

On January 27th 1945, during the final stages of World War 2, advanced units of the Russian Red Army, fighting their way into Germany, reached the vast camp complex of Auschwitz on the eastern fringes of the Greater German Reich. The German guards had hurriedly abandoned Auschwitz. Ten days earlier the SS (*Schutzstaffell*) had begun to march long columns of prisoners out of Auschwitz to other camps further west. At least a quarter of the 60,00 prisoners perished in what is now called the "Death March".
