UPDATE

The cost of installing the new heating system in Selby (£32,680.50p) was met by the Diocese on the understanding that in time, we repay the whole sum. So far, thanks to donations from individual parishioners, collections taken at funerals & baptisms we have been able to repay £12,231.00. This means that we still owe the Diocese £20,449.50p.

If everyone who puts money on the plate were to increase their offering by just 50p each week on a regular basis, that would make a tremendous difference.
