**"DAY FOR LIFE"** - is the day in the Church's year dedicated to raising awareness about the meaning and value of human life at every stage and in every condition. The Church teaches that life is to be nurtured from conception to natural death.

The theme for this year's *Day for Life*, celebrated this weekend, is: *The Wonder of the Child in the Womb*. Parenthood is a vocation of joys and hopes, of grief and anxieties. On this year's *Day for Life*, we acknowledge the particular grief of mothers and fathers who have lost a child before birth or in infancy.

The collection taken this weekend, by order of the Bishops of England & Wales, supports all organisations that work to uphold the dignity of human life.
